

HLC Utilization Course

WHO SHOULD ATTEND:

Personnel responsible for line programming using HLC.

LENGTH:

4 days

PREREQUISITES:

Familiarity with KE-700 or KE-2000 Series machines used in customer's line, strong computer skills, and complete familiarity with the Windows operating system. Understanding of networking concepts is helpful.

Attendees **MUST** be familiar with programming on KE-70 or KE-2000 Series machines as this will not be covered in depth in the HLC Operations class. Machine Specific Programming and Operations Course is strongly recommended, but not required if the student is already familiar with the machine programming.
